REGISTRATION

The cost of registration and insurance is \$35 per child. Registration fees are nonrefundable and must be paid before May 2nd.

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

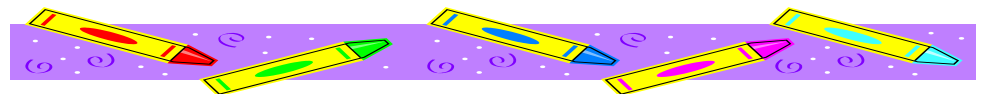
